## **Directors Report February 9,2023**

- 1) Monthly Stats November: Holds in Starcat 110, Circulation 334, Items added 83, Discards 112:
- 2) 50/50 Raffle we profited \$188.00
- 3) We are continuing to weed and organize our shelves. Also rearranging things again.
- 4) Nicole and I are still working on the website and getting things in order and looking into laws that may prohibit us from putting up scrolling things. Also, ways we can add pictures and make them A.D.A compliant for people with visual impairments.
- 5) I have started to gather some of our annual report numbers:
  - a. Patrons: 1282, Adult programs 65 with 565 participants, 26 unsponsored programs with 316 participants, 48 computer users.
  - b. I spent Friday at home working on this and have most of the report ready to go.
- 6) I have also started sorting through the files as I needed to find a document and well what better time to start.
- 7) We received our first grant of the year in partnership for both Genesee and Scio Libraries for solar glasses for the eclipse that are going to happen in 2023 and 2024. I chose to partner because the smallest number of glasses being given out was 500 and we could slit that for each library 250 glass for Scio 125 glass for the event in 10/14/2023 and 125 glasses for 2024. This grant was written from Genesee so Scio does not have to report or complete any paperwork
- 8) We received our second grant of the year from the 2023 ACWC Community Arts Grant for the amount of \$1,330.00. This grant will cover 7 weeks of mid-week music. We requested \$1,000 for the expenses. \$300.00 for Consumable art supplies and \$30.00 for advertising. This program we estimated at costing \$2,040.00 and \$1,330.00 is covered with this grant.
- 9) The Genesee library wrote a co-op grant this year to work with Genesee Valley Media and that grant has also been approved. The Scio library does not need to do anything. The program is scheduled to be during the week of August 8,9,10, & 11<sup>th</sup>. During this week Nick will come in and provide 2 hours each day of instruction and hands on learning for the youth in the area about digital media like photography, drone flying and video.
- 10) Another grant was submitted by Deb to procure funding for the rest of the expenses with the summer program.
